

"TREATMENT OF CLAY SURFACES"

This one-day workshop will explore a variety of techniques for creating interesting, multi-layered surfaces on your ceramic art. The focus will be on finishing your piece(s) using acrylics. You will learn how to create depth & interest, as well as a greater knowledge of working with color. I have used acrylics on many of my outside sculptures. There will also be samples and demonstrations with additional mediums, such as stains, under-glazes, oxides, lustres and gold-leaf. You will have ample time to experiment and leave with some finished pieces.
